

# JEE (MAIN) EXAM PATTERN

Conducting Agency	National Testing Agency (NTA)
Purpose	Admission to B.E./B.Tech. programs and qualifying exam for JEE Advanced
Exam Mode	Online (Computer-Based Test)
Duration	3 hours (4 hours for candidates with disabilities)
Total Marks	300
Total Questions	90 questions (30 questions from each subject)
Subjects	Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics
Question Type	Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) and Numerical Value Questions (NVQs)
Sections	Section A: MCQs (20 questions from each subject) Section B: NVQs (10 questions; candidates attempt 5)
Marking Scheme	+4 marks for correct answers -1 mark for incorrect answers 0 marks for un-attempted questions; For NVQs there will be no negative marking.

## Subject wise Distribution of Marks in JEE(MAIN) Exam:

Physics	Section A: 20 Questions Section B: 10 Questions(Candidates have to attempt 5)	100
Chemistry	Section A: 20 Questions Section B: 10 Questions(Candidates have to attempt 5)	100
Mathematics	Section A: 20 Questions Section B: 10 Questions(Candidates have to attempt 5)	100
Total	90	300

- Each subject has two sections: Section A consists of MCQs, while Section B contains NVQs.
- Candidates are required to attempt a total of 75 questions out of the 90 provided.
- There is no negative marking for Section B (NVQs), but there is for Section A (MCQs).
- The exam is conducted in multiple sessions, allowing candidates to choose their preferred timing.
